- **Strengthened partnerships and coordination** across countries, within countries, and between partners



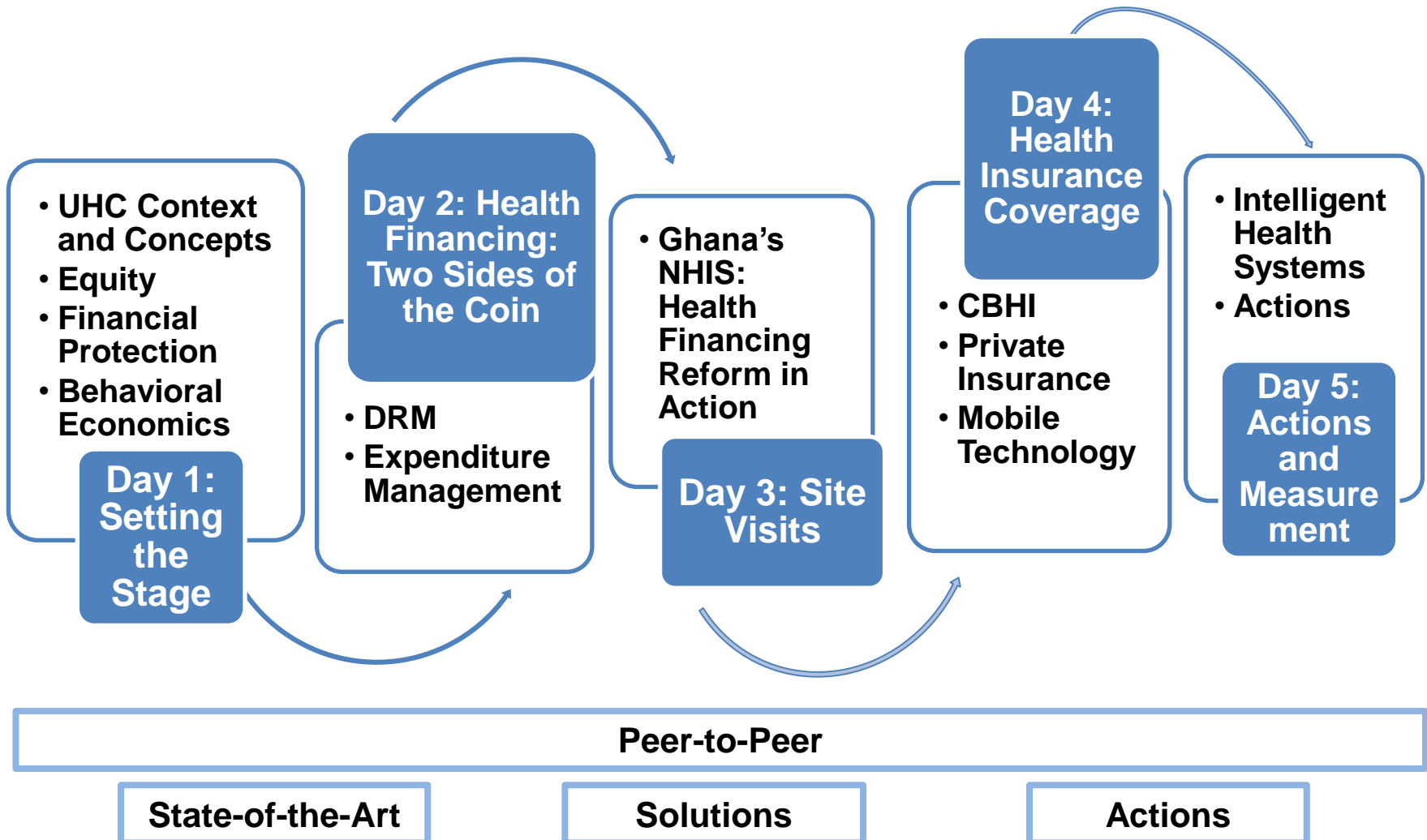
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Learning Approaches
