Next Steps – Co-development of Governing Quality Products

1. **The Guide to Institutional Roles & Relationships When Linking Finance to Quality**
 - ❖ **August-September** – Co-development of sections
 - ❖ **End of September 2017** - Draft to be circulate to this group and to the wider Community of Practice.
 - ❖ **September – November**: Piloting of the Draft Guide
 - ❖ **November/December 2017** - Initial findings from Asia qualitative research & piloting/field test to be added to the guide.
 - ❖ **December 2017** - “Final Draft” with comments incorporated circulated for review
 - ❖ **December 2017** - Guide disseminated



Next Steps – Co-development of Governing Quality Products

2. Research Agenda on Governing for Quality Care

- ❖ **August 2017** - Research specialist review to turn make questions “researchable”
- ❖ **End of August 2017** – HFG to circulate list for review by this group and wider Community of Practice
- ❖ **September 2017** – Finalization & dissemination of research agenda

3. Consensus Statement

- ❖ **August 2017** - HFG to circulate statement for review by this group and wider Community of Practice
- ❖ **September 2017** – Finalization & dissemination
